Kingsman to follow up Snowshoe with spring drilling

SNOWSHOE PROPERTY AIRBORNE SURVEY

Kingsman Resources Inc. has recently received the results of a helicopter-borne, AeroTEM II electromagnetic and magnetometer survey over its Snowshoe property, located near Greenwood in Southern British Columbia. The airborne survey was flown by Aeroquest Ltd. in December, 2005, and was successful in identifying several high-priority targets on the property. An updated National Instrument 43-101-compliant technical report is being prepared that will summarize the results of the airborne survey and make recommendations for further work.

Known mineralization on the Snowshoe property includes semi-massive to massive sulphides (with associated gold mineralization) along shear zones, as well as high-grade, gold-silver quartz veins. Both styles of mineralization are believed to be part of an Eocene mineralizing event. In excess of three million ounces of gold has been produced from Eocene-aged epithermal veins in the Republic and Curlew areas of Washington State, 20 kilometres to 40 kilometres south of the Snowshoe property. In these areas, widespread alteration is associated with the veins and has destroyed primary magnetite in the host rocks.
